

HEARTBREAK RIDGE

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When horses were used for logging, this steep ridge broke many a logger's heart because during the winter he could not haul up or down the rise.

OBERG AND LEVEAUX HIKING TRAIL (SEE REVERSE SIDE) The Oberg Mountain Hike is a 3 mile moderate loop up and around a forested mountain that offers spectacular views of Lake Superior, Oberg Lake, Moose Mountain, and the valley below. There are very steep cliffs at the top of the loop, so this may not be the best adventure for small children. The LeVeaux Mountain Trail is also accessible from the parking area.

BRITTON PEAK TRAIL

This short 5 minute trail provides a great view from the top.

THE CASCADE FALLS

AT TETTEGOUCHE STATE PARK (SEE REVERSE SIDE)

This an easy 1.5 mile out and back hike to a secluded waterfall. The trail follows the beautiful Baptism river, and there are several places for you to access the river along the way to the waterfall. When the manicured trail ends, continue around the corner to view the waterfall.

SCENIC DRIVES

There are three designated Scenic Byways to explore in the area. The North Shore Scenic Byway (MN 61) follows the birch filled shore of Lake Superior. The Gunflint Trail (Co 12) and Superior National Forest (Forest Hwy 11) Scenic Byways travel into the Forest from the shore are beautiful fall scenic drives as well.

OBERG MOUNTAIN HIKE

The Oberg Mountain Hike is a 3 mile moderate loop up and around a forested mountain that offers spectacular views of Lake Superior, Oberg Lake, Moose Mountain, and the valley below. There are very steep cliffs at the top of the loop, so this may not be the best adventure for small children. The LeVeaux Mountain Trail is also accessible from the parking area.

DRIVING DIRECTIONS: Take Highway Highway61North approximately 37 miles from Cove Point Lodge. Turn left onto Forest Road 336 (Onion River Road) This is a gravel road. Proceed up the Onion River Road for about 2 miles. You will see the trailhead sign on the right before pulling into the parking lot on the left.



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DRIVING DIRECTIONS: Tettegouche State Park - 5702 MN-61, Silver Bay, MN 55614 Head north on Highway 61 for 8.5 Miles. The Tettegouche State Park Visitors Center will be on your right. Park in the Visitor's Center lot for free, or continue past the Visitors Center to park just before the bridge. You will need a day parking pass for this. To reach the trail, walk across the bridge and follow the sign for the Cascades Trail.
